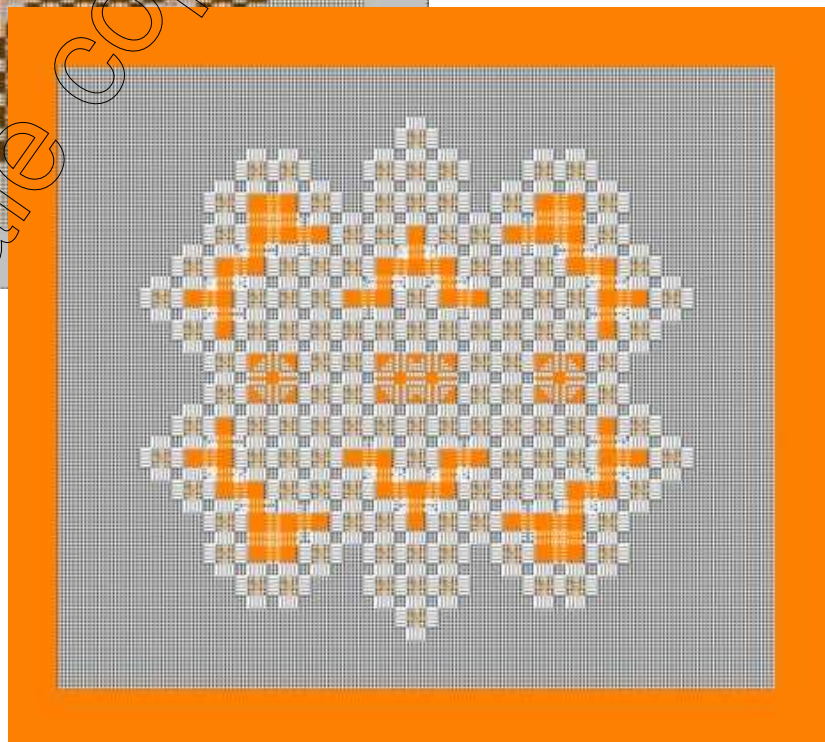
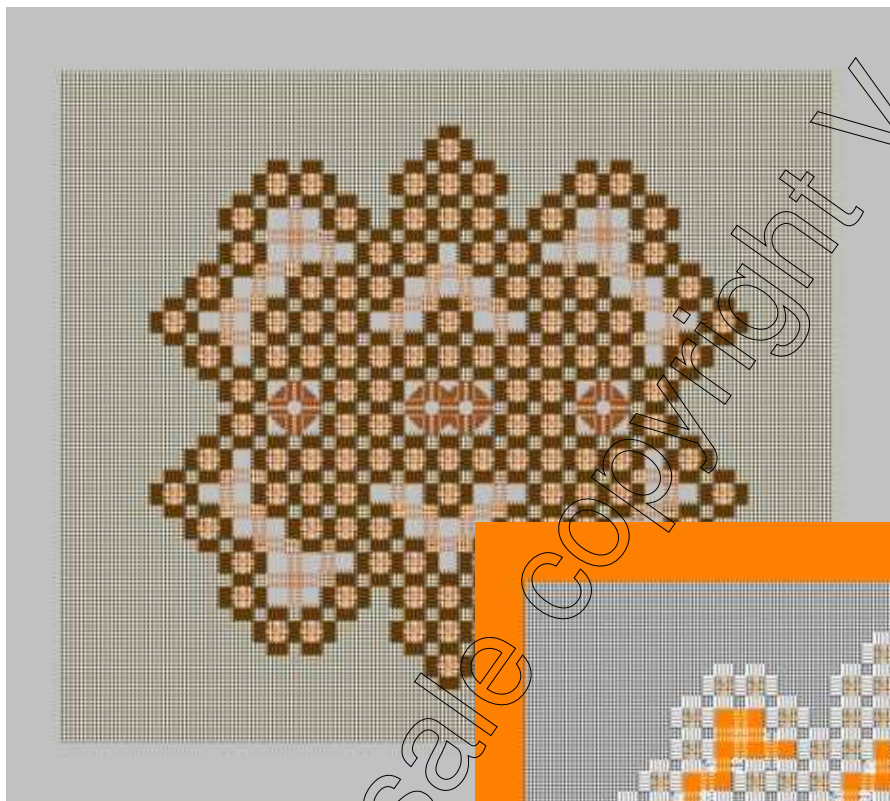

Please behave wisely.

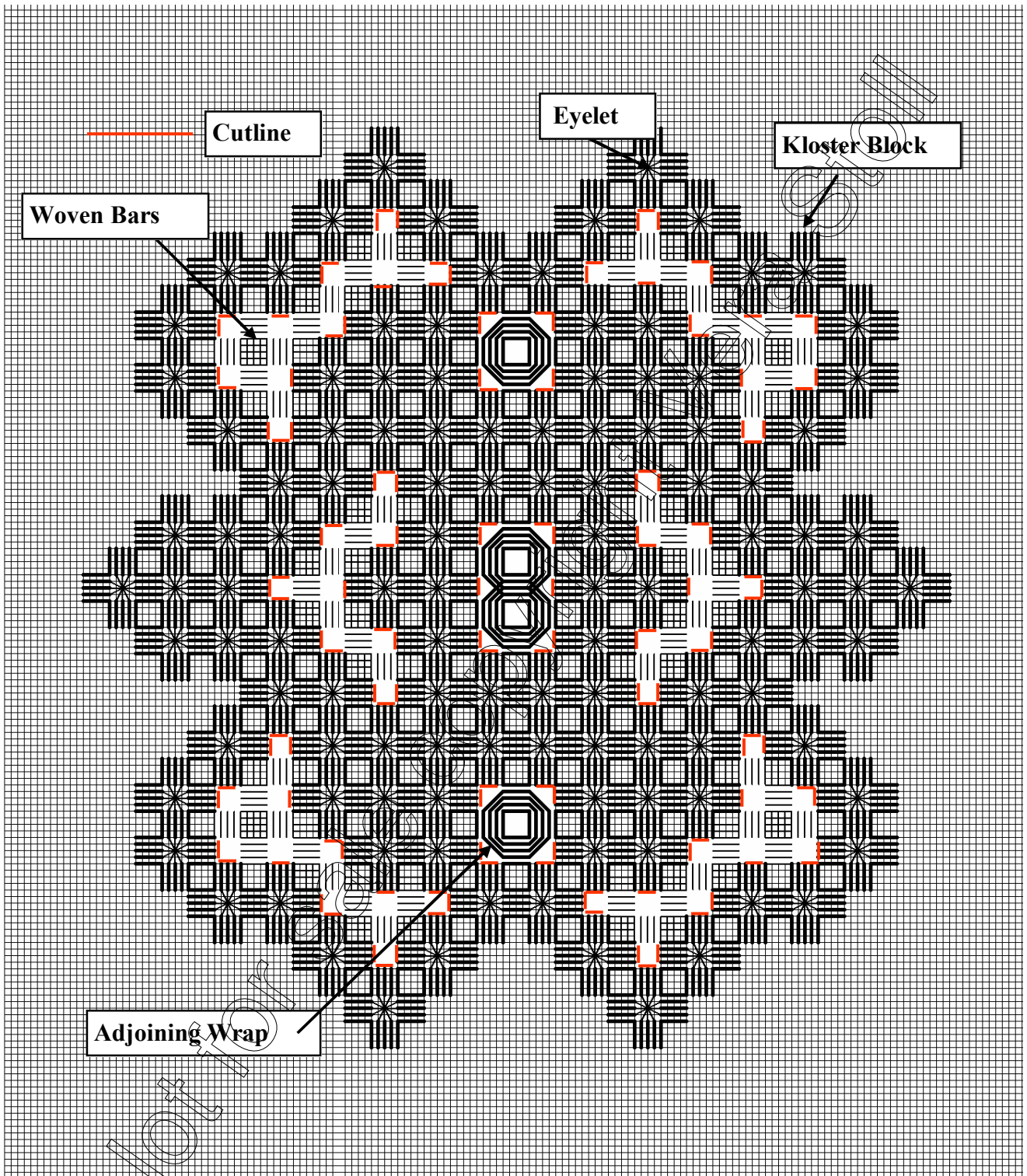

Working Instructions

Welcome

Doily

- Step 1: Start with the first satin stitch block (kloster block).
- Step 2: Stitch the eyelets before you cut the threads. If you cut beforehand, you may have problems with the fabric. You could pull threads out of the fabric and destroy it this way.
- Step 3: Cut the threads with a sharp pair of scissors. I marked the lines where to cut in red. Work carefully.
- Step 4: Congratulation, you finished a jewel for your home.

Attention:

This chart has been designed individually and printed carefully with my best intentions of being without mistakes. However, the possibility of human error, printing mistakes or a variation of individual stitching does exist. I regret this. But I cannot be made responsible for it.
